#### 1.- Informed consent

All patients whose samples and associated data are deposited at BICUIB are aware of and have signed the Informed Consent form authorising their inclusion at BICUIB and the use of said samples to undertake research projects and studies.

The informed consent form shall be issued in triplicate. One copy shall be for the source subject, one held by the centre where the sample was obtained (in the Clinical Records) and one held by the Biobank.

Traceability of the biological samples and associated data is a task coordinated by the depositaries and Biobank, and must be ensured by law (Act 14/2007 on Biomedical Research).

#### 5. Depositing data associated with the samples

Depositaries of samples may provide the Biobank with associated data (gender, age, biochemistry, clinical records, etc.) so as to make their transfer possible to undertake projects, in accordance with the operating system at biobanks. These data may be retrospectively included in the Deposit Project or prospectively in the Request received by the Biobank. In both instances, obtaining these data must be authorised by the relevant Ethics Committee.

#### 6. Sample and data transfer to third parties

The Biobank shall be responsible for transfers to research projects that have been approved by its external committees. In any event, the Biobank shall consult the depositary before transferring to third parties and their opinion may be assessed by the external scientific committee.

#### 7. Activities in case of contingencies

The Biobank shall dispose of the samples deposited at the depositary's request in order to comply with the right of patients to withdraw samples deposited at the Biobank, amongst others.
