

## TEMPLATE FOR COST RECOVERY FROM THIRD PARTIES FOR SAMPLE TRANSFER

In accordance with Article 4 d) of Royal Degree 1716/2011 of 18<sup>th</sup> November that sets out the Basic Authorisation and Operation Requirements for Biobanks for biomedical research purposes, said biobanks for research purposes must perform their activities pro bono. Nevertheless, biobanks may recover the costs of obtaining, transferring, maintaining, handling, processing, dispatching and other similar costs related to sample for each sample transfer, in accordance with what is set out in Article 69.3 of Act 14/2007 of 3<sup>rd</sup> July.

In line with this, BICUIB provides a cost recovery template that sets out the factors to take into account in establishing applicable BICUIB fees.
